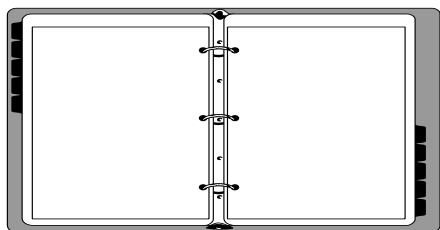

## Forthcoming Collection

### CAFOD Lenten Fast Day – Friday 27<sup>th</sup> February

The collection of the fast day envelopes (given out the preceding weekend 21<sup>st</sup>/22<sup>nd</sup> February) will be taken up on the following weekend **28<sup>th</sup>/29<sup>th</sup> February**.

Please note that this Lenten appeal will have matching funding from the UK Government. **Donations between Ash Wednesday (18<sup>th</sup> February) and Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> May will be matched £1 for £1.**

For this Lent CAFOD will be focussing on their work in Myanmar (formerly Burma) where they have helped communities get back on to their feet after the devastating impact of Cyclone Nargis back in 2009. Cyclone Nargis was the strongest cyclone ever to hit Myanmar. Over 150,000 people died, and 2.4 million were affected. Kyin Nu was one of those affected. Half of her village people were killed. By planting trees, providing animals and paying people to rebuild roads and protective embankments, we have helped Kyin Nu and the rest of her community get back on their feet.

### National Justice & Peace Conference – Saturday 14<sup>th</sup> February

CAFOD South Wales will be at this conference held at St. David's Sixth Form College, Ty Gwyn Road, Cardiff CF23 6XL from 10am to 4pm. The title of the conference is "A vision for the common good", which will include the speaker Alison Jackson – chairperson of trustees of Church Action on Poverty. All are welcome to attend.

### Toiletries for Asylum Seekers – NEXT WEEKEND

The first of this year's collection of toiletries for the Welsh Refugee Council comes round **next weekend 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> February**. You are asked to donate mostly toiletries for men, who are destitute and in most need.
