#### WELCOME TO OUR ARCHBISHOP-ELECT.

As you know, Pope Francis has appointed Bishop Mark O'Toole as Archbishop-elect of Cardiff and Bishop-elect of Menevia. We welcome him to the diocese and wish him many years of fruitful ministry among us. The date of his installation as Archbishop of Cardiff has been arranged for June 20th.

Bishop Mark O'Toole has been Bishop of Plymouth since his appointment in 2013. Previously, he was ordained a priest for the Archdiocese of Westminster in 1990 and served as private secretary to Cardinal Cormac Murphy-O'Connnor between 2002-2008, before his appointment as the Rector of Allen Hall seminary in London, in 2008.

#### **GOLDEN JUBILEE OF PRIESTHOOD.**

Archbishop George will celebrate his Golden Jubilee of Priestly Ordination on Saturday 21st May 2022 with a Mass of Thanksgiving in the Cathedral at 12 noon. Afterwards there will be a Reception at the Cornerstone in Charles Street. Two representatives from each parish around the diocese have been invited and will be attending the celebration.

#### PRIEST'S TRAINING FUND – NEXT WEEK.

The annual special collection for the PTF takes place next weekend on 7th/8th May, coinciding with Good Shepherd Sunday and World Day of Prayer for Vocations. It takes in excess of £20,000 per year to put each student through Seminary. Assisted by your prayers and generosity over recent years, we have one student, **Rev. Elliot Hanson** from Barry, who is going to be ordained a priest for this Archdiocese on 16th July, and **Dale Cutlan**, from Aberdare, who will be ordained a transitional Deacon this summer. He will be ordained a priest next year.

The special collection will be taken as you leave the church after all Masses next weekend. There are special envelopes and leaflets to accompany the Appeal. Please take an envelope and bring it back next week with your donation. You can Gift Aid your donation if you are a taxpayer. For the first time, parishioners can also make recurring regular monthly donations online via the Diocesan website at www.rcadc.org/priest-training-fund.

This year the diocese is also piloting a "Friends of the Priest's Training Fund" scheme. Parishioners are encouraged to pay for one day of a priest's training per year via a monthly standing order of £6.50. Bank details are on the Diocesan website.
