Making More Space in the church (St. Mary's)!

At the last meeting of the PAC (1st May) Canon Joe proposed some minor alterations to the interior of the church in order to create more space. These alterations will be done before the inside of the church is re-decorated. It was decided that:

1. The old baptism font will be removed. The font has not been used for many years and its position is totally impractical and not fit for purpose. The moveable font which is used for baptisms has been re-located in the Blessed Sacrament chapel. It will be brought out for baptisms.
2. The bookcase and books in the baptistry area will also be removed. **If anyone has donated books and would like to claim them back, please do so before the end of June.** At the end of that period the books and bookcase will be disposed of. In this way the old baptistry area will provide extra capacity on the big occasions.
3. **St. Mary's Hall:** We have already created a lot more space in the hall by disposing of the piano and the table tennis table. Canon Joe agrees that the old pool table is also taking up valuable space and he has asked that enquiries be made with a view to finding out if it is of use to anyone.
