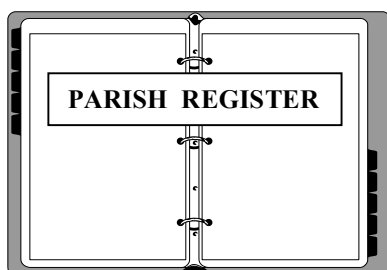
SPUC 45th ANNUAL 10KM SPONSORED WALK
