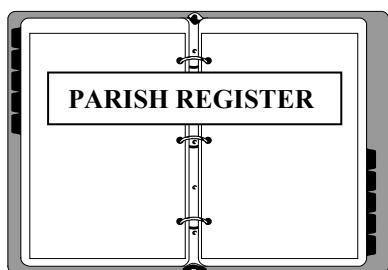
#### CYCLE OF PRAYER FOR PARISHES.

### WHAT HAPPENS AFTER 7<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST?

We are expecting the First Minister to set out his strategy for lifting most of the current Covid restrictions on 7<sup>th</sup> August.

It depends on the "science" of course but even with the rate of infections going up and down as they are at the moment, it looks like the Welsh Government will give the green light. The First Minister and his advisors have always favoured the cautious approach, as the sensible way forward, and this is the policy we have tried to follow over the duration of the pandemic. Whatever we have done, it had to be safe for all concerned.

After 7<sup>th</sup> August things will largely stay as they are, to allow for a period of re-evaluation to take place. On Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> August, Mgr. Joe will meet with his small team of advisors, who have been with him throughout the duration of the pandemic, and they will discuss the proposals put forward by the Welsh Government and respond accordingly. They will also bear in mind the guidelines issued by the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales.

There will be some major changes that will see an increase in our Sunday congregations and in the way we have come to organise the celebration of Mass and other liturgical events. At each step however, a risk assessment will have to be carried out to make sure that the safety of all comes first.

### GOING BACK TO "THE DAY OF THE LORD".

The Bishops of England and Wales are conscious that the lifting of the Sunday Obligation, which has been allowed during the pandemic, cannot go on indefinitely. For the moment however, they are conscious that the Covid-19 virus is still circulating in society. It is their continuing judgement therefore that it is not possible or safe at the present time for all the faithful to attend Mass on a Sunday, thus fulfilling their duty to God.

However, it is hoped that it will be possible for all Catholics in England and Wales to fulfil this most important Church precept - that of the Sunday obligation - by the First Sunday in Advent 2021. In the meantime, all Catholics are asked to do their best to participate in the celebration of the weekly Sunday Mass and to reflect deeply on the centrality of Sunday worship in the life of the Church.
