##### ST. MARY'S SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION 2019/20

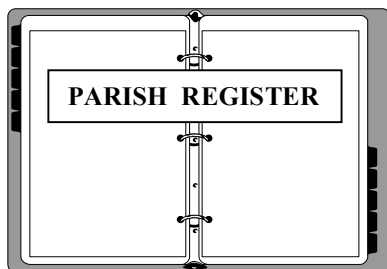
