This Fast Day we are taking inspiration from a prayer used to remember the Blessed Oscar Romero, the Archbishop of San Salvador who was murdered while he was celebrating Mass because he stood up for the poorest people in his country. "We plant the seeds that one day will grow. We nurture seeds already planted, knowing that they hold future promise. ...It may be incomplete, but it is a beginning, a step along the way, an opportunity for the Lord's grace to enter and do the rest."

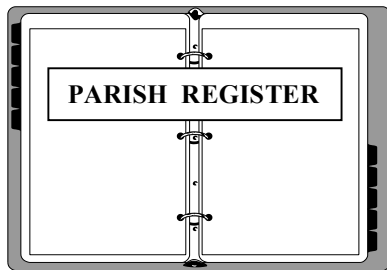
