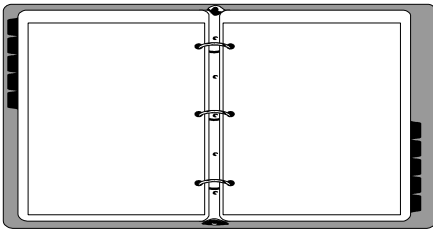

Forthcoming collections

Homelessness Sunday - Second Collection- next weekend 8th/9th Feb. for Home Access.

Home Access was set up to help people who are homeless.

The staff at Home Access (located at Tabernacle Baptist Church) ensures that each client obtains secure accommodation that is suitable and free from disrepair. It also provides bonds to landlords for this purpose. Proper inventories are carried out prior to clients moving in. Home Access staff also assists with housing benefit claims and checks that full entitlement is secured. Follow up procedures ensure that clients are not forgotten.

Funding, of course, is required to maintain this voluntary service and it is hoped you will give generously to help this work continue. **A second collection will be taken at all Masses on the weekend 8th/ 9th February for Home Access. In supporting Home Access you will also be helping Tabs to run the Penarth Food Bank.**
