### SCRIPTURE STUDY DAYS – *The Year of the God*

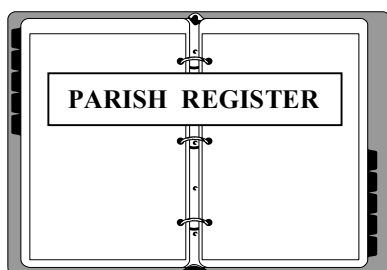

### INVITATION FROM THE DEAN OF HEREFORD CATHEDRAL – FRIDAY 17<sup>th</sup> APRIL

In 2020, at Hereford Cathedral, we are celebrating the **700<sup>th</sup> anniversary** of the **Canonisation of Thomas Cantilupe** on 17<sup>th</sup> April 1320 by Pope John XXII and a year-long programme of events is already underway.

We have close links with Belmont Abbey and with the church of **St. Francis Xavier** and after discussions with the Abbot and other Catholic friends, we have the pleasure in hosting the **celebration of Mass** on the **actual anniversary of the Canonisation – Friday 17<sup>th</sup> April 2020 at 11.00am.**

Mass will be celebrated by the **Archbishop of Cardiff, the Most Revd George Stack** and during Mass, there will be a procession to the **refurbished shrine of St. Thomas**, in the north transept. Here will be displayed, for veneration, **relics of St. Thomas**, for which the Cathedral is caring during this festival year (relics owned by Downside Abbey and Stonyhurst College).

**The Abbot and the Dean of Hereford** feel that this is a **wonderful opportunity** to invite **priests and congregations** from the **Archdiocese of Cardiff** and also from neighbouring parishes in Birmingham Archdiocese. They would be delighted to welcome you here for this historic occasion.
