WIDESPREAD FAMINE ACROSS EAST AFRICA

Pictures of the **desperate situation** facing millions of people in **South Sudan, Northern Kenya, Somalia and Ethiopia** have flooded our living rooms via the news channels on our TV's. CAFOD, which is in partnership with other Aid Agencies, has asked us to **respond immediately to this crisis** despite the fact that we have only just had our Lenten Fast Day Appeal. **The situation is so urgent that our response cannot be delayed.** There will be a second collection at all masses **THIS weekend 1st – 2nd of April** (5th Sunday of Lent) for the **East Africa Crisis Appeal**. STATIONS OF THE CROSS & BENEDICTION FOR LENT.

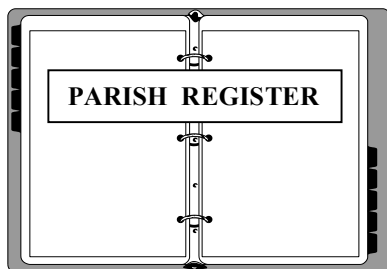
