CHRISM MASS

The Chrism Mass takes place in St David's Cathedral, Cardiff on Tuesday 4th April at 11:30am.

THE SACRED TRIDUUM

The times of the Holy Week services in St Joseph's are set out on the back page of this newsletter. Even though most COVID restrictions have been removed this year and the Holy Week services are open to everyone, it is still necessary to exercise a degree of caution, whilst at the same time moving forward where we can.

MASS OF THE LORD'S SUPPER - Thursday WASHING OF FEET - we are looking for six parishioners, men and women, to come forward to have their feet washed. Each will have an individual towel with which the priest will dry their feet afterwards

GOOD FRIDAY – SOLEMN LITURGY.

The Veneration of the Cross. There will be no kissing of the cross during the veneration. Like last year each person should approach the cross and make a profound bow, before returning to their pew.

HOLY SATURDAY: THE EASTER VIGIL

After the blessing of the Easter water and the renewal of Baptismal promises, the Easter water will be poured into the stoops at the back of both churches and left there for people to use as they enter or leave the church once again.

EASTER SUNDAY MORNING MASSES. Lighted candles will not be held during the renewal of Baptismal Promises. This is for Health and Safety reasons.



HOLY SATURDAY: THE IN-BETWEEN TIME

On Holy Saturday the Church waits at the Lord's tomb, meditating on his suffering and death. The altar is left bare and the sacrifice of the Mass is not celebrated. Only after the solemn vigil during the night, held in anticipation of the resurrection, does the Easter celebration begin, with a spirit of joy that overflows into the following period of 50 days. Holy Saturday is a day of quiet waiting, or prayerful preparation for the Resurrection. There is still sorrow, even if it lacks the intensity of the preceding day. If we can spend this day in quiet and prayerful waiting, our time will have been well spent. On the first Holy Saturday all seemed lost. The disciples were scattered. Only Mary kept faith and awaited the resurrection of her son. That is why on Saturdays throughout the year, the Church commemorates the Virgin Mary, and there is a votive mass in her honour.
