ST JOSEPH'S SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION 2018/19

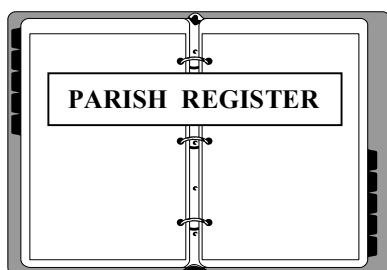

THE NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC CONGRESS.

The Eucharistic Congress takes place in Liverpool from **Friday 7th September until Sunday 9th September.** 150 pilgrims from all over the Archdiocese of Cardiff will be making the trip on Saturday 8th September. They will be transported there and back in three coaches. Deacon Elfed will be going representing St. Joseph's, and Val Kacal and David Moreau will represent St. Mary's. A Eucharistic Congress reminds us that the Eucharist is at the heart of our parish communities – as Holy Mass and also as Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament outside of Mass. Both contain the Real Presence of the Lord. We must never take that reality for granted or become lukewarm in our appreciation of it. It is, after all, God's greatest gift to us.

We will remember in our prayers all those who are taking part in the Congress and hope that this most wonderful gathering will bring many blessings on our diocese and the dioceses of England and Wales.

HOME MISSION SUNDAY – 15TH/16TH SEPT.

Home Mission Sunday provides us with the opportunity to focus on this Mission; pray for it; and prompt some to actively take part in it. At the same time, the second collection for this Sunday supports the work of the Home Mission Office in London. Their vision is to help the Local Church to make the joy of the Gospel a reality in England and Wales.

Since our impression of Jesus can either help or hinder our desire to talk about him, the focus of this Home Mission Sunday on 16th September is to pose the question Jesus asked his disciples: "Who do you say I am?"
The money you give to this collection does not go abroad, but is used to help Catholics in England and Wales become more confident in sharing their faith.

MISSION APPEAL NEXT WEEK.

Next weekend 8th/9th September, Fr. Emmanuel, a Missionary priest from the Holy Ghost Fathers (now called the Spiritans) will be making the annual Missionary Appeal at all Masses. The second collection will be given to him to support them in their work around the world.
