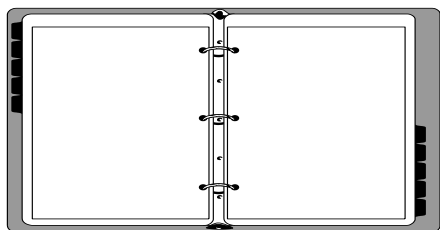

### The Light is ON for US

Archbishop George has launched in the Cardiff Archdiocese the high –profile initiative “*The Light is ON for You*”, to invite practising and lapsed Catholics to go to Confession this Advent. In common with other dioceses across England and Wales, we are reaching out to those who may have wandered from the life of the Church and those Mass-going Catholics who have been away from Confession for some years. Each Wednesday of Advent participating Catholic Parish Churches in the Archdiocese of Cardiff will be open from **7pm to 8pm on 3<sup>rd</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> December** for Catholics to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation. This means that “*The Light is ON for You*” at these times in St. Joseph's, Penarth.

Mgr John Maguire, parish priest of St. Mary's, Canton will be hearing confessions in Penarth, while Canon Joe will go to Canton.

### November – The Month of Remembrance

On the following **Tuesdays: Oct 28<sup>th</sup>, Nov 4<sup>th</sup>, Nov 11<sup>th</sup> and Nov 25<sup>th</sup>**, there will be a series of half-hour talks at the Cornerstone in Charles \Street, (opposite St. David's Cathedral), at 12.30pm, on subjects related to Life and Death. Refreshments will be served after the talks.

- **4<sup>th</sup> November: *Preparing Well for Eternal Life.***

Dom Paul Stonham OSB, Abbot of Belmont reflects on his experience in Latin America on this subject.

- **11<sup>th</sup> November: *Purification, Punishment, or Popish Propaganda?*** Rev Gareth Leyshon takes a fresh look at Purgatory.

- **25<sup>th</sup> November: *Life after Death.*** Mr Des Robertson asks what the Catholic Church teaches us about death.

**Every Wednesday during the month of November**, the Cornerstone will be “open to the public” from 11am to 2.30pm as a place of reflection for anyone who feels conscious of bereavement. Drop in at any time during these hours to find a warm welcome. Trained bereavement support volunteers will be available to listen and to talk with anyone who wishes to do so; there will also be reflective spots set up for people who just want to sit and reflect and pray. Refreshments will be available.

- There will be a special prayer service (not a Mass) for anyone whose life has been touched by the loss of a child in the womb, through birth or miscarriage, on **Friday 14<sup>th</sup> November** at Christ the King Church in Llanishen. The service will be offered twice, first at 1.30pm and again at 7.30pm.
