ASH WEDNESDAY – There will be two Masses on Ash Wednesday with blessing and distribution of Ashes:
St. Joseph's 10am and St. Mary's 7.30pm.

SYRIAN FAMILIES IN THE ARCHDIOCESE

As a fourth Archdiocese property is made ready for occupation, more families will be welcomed into the local community. These families will be the focus of this year's **Diocesan Lenten Project**. A second collection will be taken on the **5th Sunday of Lent** as in previous years.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS & BENEDICTION

FOR LENT – On the **six Sundays of Lent** up to and including Palm Sunday, there will be the traditional **Stations of the Cross and Benediction** beginning at **4pm** in **St. Joseph's**.

EXTRA CONFESSIONS DURING LENT

In addition to the weekly Confessions in St. Joseph's and St. Mary's on Saturdays, there will be an **extra opportunity for Reconciliation** in **St. Joseph's, Penarth**, on **Friday evenings** during Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament from **6.15pm**.

PENARTH CYTUN LENTEN LUNCHES – These will be held for **6 weeks every Friday from the 8th March** with St. Joseph's and St. Mary's working with Stanwell Road Baptist first on the rota. The lunches will be held in Stanwell Road Baptist Church Hall from **12-1.30pm**. Tickets **£5** with proceeds to Christian Aid.

LENT 2019

WALK WITH ME – This **pocket-size** booklet of **prayers and reflections** for **Lent 2019** is **now available at the back of church**. It costs **£1** and supports parish funds. The focus of this year's **Walk With Me** is 'Living a Holy Life'. Archbishop George Stack, Bishop Tom Burns and Bishop Peter Brignall have written a foreword to the booklet and recommend it as an **aid to prayer**. In the introduction, we read, "During these Forty Days of Lent Jesus invites us to 'Walk With Me'. May the readings and prayers contained in this short booklet help us to realise that he continues to accompany us on our journey towards Easter and beyond."

RCIA: THE RITE OF ELECTION NEXT SUNDAY

This involves those who have been preparing for **adult Baptism** at Easter or **Reception into the Catholic Church** for those already baptised. The **Rite of Election**, in the presence of **Archbishop George Stack**, will take place in **St. David's Cathedral** **NEXT Sunday 10th March** at **3pm**. We have one candidate for Reception and his name is **BOB WILLIAMS**. Bob has attended **all the RCIA classes** since October and he will now attend the Rite of Election with his catechists and his sponsor. Please keep him in your prayers as he takes this **decisive step** on his journey to Easter.

LENTEN TALKS – These talks will be held at the Cornerstone on **each Friday of Lent** up to **12th April**. All talks start at **1.30pm** and are available with a **soup and roll lunch** (donation welcome). **Abbot Paul Stonham** of **Belmont Abbey**, the **Lord Mayor of Cardiff**, as well as clergy and religious from the diocese, will be on hand to lead our spiritual journey in Lent.
