On Wednesday this week we celebrated the Feast of SS Peter & Paul. On the following Sunday (today) we take a **second collection** for Peter's Pence. This is the Holy Father's own worldwide collection for his Charities. It is also our opportunity to share in his outreach and in the wider Mission of the Church.

## THE SYNOD OF BISHOPS 2023.

The National Synthesis Team have completed their compilation of the diocesan responses to the Synodal consultation and it has been presented to the Bishops' Conference. The next stage in this work is for the Bishops to produce a document based on the national synthesis for submission to the Synod Office in Rome. This will be considered along with the other national synthesis documents from around the world, and from these, the Synod Office will produce the *Instrumentum Laboris 1* for the work at the European (Regional) phase.

And so, the journey of becoming a Synodal Church continues, as we move forward to the Regional phase, that will continue the reflections and work here in England and Wales at the local, diocesan and national level.
