MISSIONARY APPEAL THIS WEEKEND.

Before Covid we used to extend our parish hospitality to various Missionary priests and nuns who would come among us with their stories of Mission Lands and their experiences of spreading the Gospel in hostile environments. This weekend (Sept 2nd / 3rd) we welcome Fr. John Convery s.x. who is a Xaverian Missionary. He will preach the annual Mission Appeal on behalf of the St. Francis Xavier Foreign Mission Society. The Xaverian Missionaries first came to the UK in 1948 with the goal of inviting others to join their missionary purpose and commit themselves to the proclamation of the Good News around the world.

SEASON OF CREATION

The Season of Creation runs from 1st September (World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation) to 4 October (the feast of Saint Francis of Assisi) each year. This ecumenical season is dedicated to prayer and action for the protection of creation. It is a time to renew our relationships with God our Creator, and with all creation, as we join together in prayer. We give thanks for all that God has made, repent for the damage that we have caused and commit ourselves to take action to protect the earth our common home.

"Let Justice and Peace Flow" is the theme and invitation of this year's Season of Creation. In his message for the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation 2023, Pope Francis encourages us to "live, work and pray that our common home will teem with life once again."

SEASON OF CREATION - VIGILS

To mark this special time, which begins on 1st September until 4th October, Christian Climate Action is issuing the invitation to take part in a series of silent vigils for Climate Justice. They will be held on the Hayes, Cardiff, outside Barclays Bank. This bank is Europe's leading fossil fuel investor. Since 2016 Barclays has invested an estimated £150 billion in fossil fuel companies. The JPIC will gather for an hour of silent prayer as an act of grief for those dying because of climate chaos and to pray that Barclays stops funding climate breakdown. Please join us on the Saturdays of September from 11am to 12 noon.

J&P GROUP HANDOUT NEXT WEEK.

Members of the Justice and Peace Group will be distributing their Handout which updates the Parish on the projects with which they have been involved in recent months. This will be available on the weekends of Sept 9th and 16th. You will hear about CAFOD "Fix the Food System Campaign", which is focusing particularly on seeds. Small farmers who produce the majority of the world's food, need to be able to choose which seeds to plant and should also be able to share these seeds. This power is being taken away from them by big institutions and international Corporations. Thousands of people in many parishes across Britain have already told the UK Government to urge to World Bank to protect the rights of farmers. You too will have a chance to sign the letter of support of Salina, a small scale farmer from Bangladesh, who has written to the World Bank herself on this important matter. The signing will take place after Masses on the two weekends mentioned earlier.
