### CYCLE OF PRAYER FOR PARISHES.

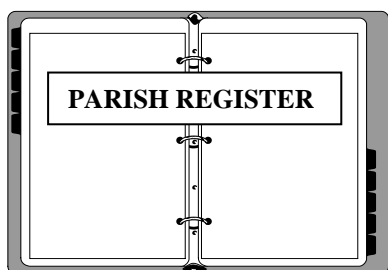
This week it is the turn of St. Patrick's, Grangetown. The Parish Priest is Canon Mike Evans. There is also St. Patrick's Primary School.
