EXTRA CONFESSIONS DURING LENT – PENARTH.

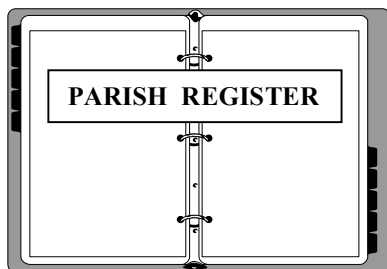
