### PUBLIC MASSES RETURN NEXT WEEKEND.

Weekend Masses with a congregation will re-commence in St. Joseph's from next weekend ie. April 10th/11<sup>th</sup>. It will involve only the weekend Masses (ie. 5pm Sat and 9.30am Sun). These Masses will still be subject to social distancing etc. and therefore restricted to 50 persons per Mass. Admission will be on a "first come" basis. Weekday Masses – Mon, Wed, and Fri - will continue to be streamed live. Hopefully, as further restrictions are eased in May and June, we can slowly get parish life back on track with a greater degree of normality.

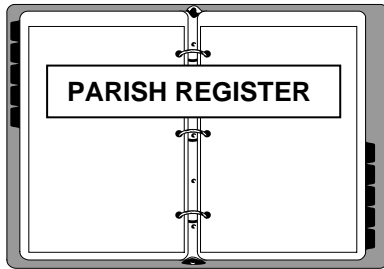
