### **SEASONS OF CREATION**

The season of Creation runs from 1st of September (world day of prayer for the care of creation) to 4<sup>th</sup> of October, the feast of St. Francis. This ecumenical season is dedicated to prayer and action for the protection of creation. It is a time to renew our relationship with God our creator and with all creation, as we join together in prayer. We give thanks for all that God has made, repent of the damage that we have caused and commit ourselves to take action to protect the earth, our common home. "Listen to the voice of creation" is the theme and invitation of this year's season of creation. Pope Francis calls on us to "cultivate our ecological conversion" and to pray in "the great cathedral of creation". ### **CAFOD's "Fix the food system" Campaign**

What do we mean by the "food system"? It's the way food is produced, processed, transported, marketed, consumed and wasted. We produce more than enough food for everyone yet around the world 800 million people go hungry and a lot of them are the people who produce the food. But the system isn't really designed to feed everyone. A few large companies (agribusinesses) have a huge influence. They push for the expansion of crops they can sell to other countries for the most money - crops for export. If small farmers want to choose crops which are more nutritious or better for their communities they face all kinds of obstacles. This generates a massive imbalance of power. CAFOD wants to persuade our government to work internationally to change the system to one rooted in **Food Sovereignty**. This is the right of people to decide their food systems putting their cultural and nutritional needs first rather than the demands imposed by the market and big business.

Also, about a third of all the global greenhouse gases that we are putting into the atmosphere each year are from the way we produce our food.
