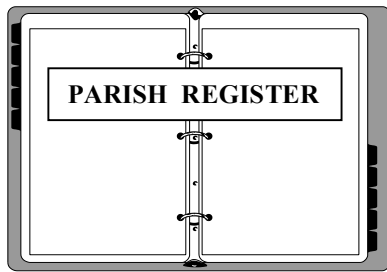

### WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR VOCATIONS

**11<sup>th</sup> / 12<sup>th</sup> May, GOOD SHEPHERD SUNDAY (4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter).** NEXT SUNDAY is a day of Prayer for Vocations to the Priesthood and Consecrated Life. *'Behind every vocation ... there is always (the) prayer of someone'* (Pope Francis reminds us). We have seen the **fruits of our prayers** as **two** of our **five students** in Seminary were ordained priests last summer for this diocese. From the **three** remaining students, **one** will be ordained a priest on the 22<sup>nd</sup> June; he is **Laurence Bryce**. The other two students, **Elliot Hanson** and **Dale Cutlan**, are following in his footsteps. Please **keep them in your prayers**. There will be a **SECOND COLLECTION NEXT WEEK** for the **Priests' Training Fund (PTF)**. It takes **£20,000** to train a student per year (over 7 years). The PTF needs **topping up each year** to meet the costs. **Special gift aid envelopes will be available this weekend and you can pick one up as you leave the church if you wish**. Tax payers can complete the Gift Aid declaration. We must continue to pray for vocations. We can never sit back and be complacent. Remember our senior clergy will have to be replaced one day.

### CANON JOE WILL BE TAKING TIME OUT

Canon will be going into hospital for a minor operation on Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> May. He will be out of action for a couple of weeks. The weekend Masses in St. Joseph's and St. Mary's on the weekend of 11<sup>th</sup> / 12<sup>th</sup> May will be as normal, and will be covered by Monsignor Bob Reardon. Meanwhile Eucharistic services will continue on weekdays from Monday 13<sup>th</sup> May. Confirmation (17<sup>th</sup> May) and First Holy Communion (19<sup>th</sup> May SJ) and (26<sup>th</sup> May SM) will not be affected. However with the cancellation of Masses, some **Mass Intentions** have had to be deferred to later dates.

### – MASS FOR THE SICK –

The **annual Mass** with the **anointing of the sick** was scheduled to take place at **12 noon** in **St. Joseph's Primary School**, on **Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> July**.

It now transpires that due to major building work the school will not be available this year.

Canon Joe is exploring other alternatives but at the moment nothing has been finalised. Changing the date or venue is proving to be difficult. It would be a shame if we had to cancel, but even this is a possibility.

We have only learned of this problem just before going to print. Hopefully by next week, conversations can take place and more information will be available.

This **annual Mass** was introduced to the Parish some years ago by **Canon Joe**, so that the **sick, elderly and housebound** in care homes or in their own homes could be brought together in **St. Joseph's School**, where they could receive the **Sacrament of the Sick** during a **special Mass**. Canon Joe could not otherwise get around to see them all individually by himself.

It has proved to be a **popular event** and has drawn from **both our parish communities an army of helpers and voluntary support** who make it all possible. We are grateful to **Mr. Gareth Rein, Head Teacher** of St. Joseph's and his staff, who have made the school premises available to us over the years.

Every effort will be made to ensure the continuity of this annual parish event.
