RE-OPENING OF ST JOSEPH'S CHURCH – UPDATE

We are making progress with the various conditions we have to meet before we can open St. Joseph's church for private prayer. However, we are not quite there yet. At the end of the day we will have to obtain the approval of the Archdiocese who will finally give permission for us to open. We are still working on that.

VOLUNTEER STEWARDS.

Thank you to those who put their names forward as Stewards in response to last week's Appeal. We have nine names and one in reserve. This means that with 3 stewards on duty at any one time, we can open the church three times a week – Monday, Wednesday, and Friday – from 10.30am until 12 noon. That is the plan.

The volunteer Stewards will be contacted during the week and a meeting with them will be arranged for next Saturday, July 11th, in the church at 2pm. Covid restrictions will be observed. Although we cannot yet put a date on the opening, we are getting there. It won't be long now.

LIVE STREAMING OF MASS FROM ST. JOSEPH'S.

Mgr. Joe is hoping to commence streaming Masses from St. Joseph's from next weekend (July 11th/12th). The "Link" on our website to "Live Mass" will, from then on, take you to here at St Joseph's instead of St. Mary's, Canton. Those who want to stay with Canton will have to visit their website via Google. The first Mass to be streamed will be at 5pm on Saturday. On Sunday morning Mass will be at 11.15am. Weekday Masses from Monday to Friday (July 13th-17th) will be at 9.30am. These are familiar Mass times to us.

TOILETRIES DROP NEXT WEEKEND (July 11th-12th)

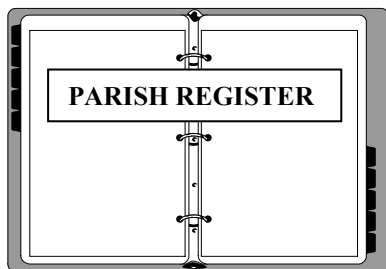
We have heard that Sister Ruth, who works with Home4U, the drop-in centre for destitute asylum seekers in Newport Rd, are desperately short of Toiletries. Of course, because of the Lockdown, we have been unable to organise the usual quarterly Toiletries Drops in the church. With this in mind we want to arrange for bags of Toiletries to be taken to the **church grounds**, where members of the Justice and Peace Group will be waiting in their cars to collect them from you. Sister Ruth says that their current priorities are for soap, shower gel, shampoo, toothpaste and toothbrushes, deodorants, shaving cream, toilet rolls, female sanitary products, hand cream and hand sanitisers. Face masks would also be greatly appreciated.

The plan therefore is as follows:

A car belonging to a member of the J&P Group will be parked in front of the presbytery in St. Joseph's, and another one in the car park in St. Mary's, Dinas Powys, **between 2pm and 3pm** next Saturday 11th July. Donors are requested to put the toiletries in a bag which can be placed in the car boot. There will be no need for any physical contact. Social distancing will be observed at all times.

The Toiletries Drop will then be repeated on Sunday 12th July, again from 2pm to 3pm in the same way.

The need is great and so your generosity would be appreciated in these extraordinary and uncertain times. Although there are difficult times ahead for many people, nevertheless it is always the poor and the marginalized that feel the full impact most, because they have little or nothing to begin with and have no defence mechanism in place.
