GOD WHO SPEAKS – STUDY DAY COMING.

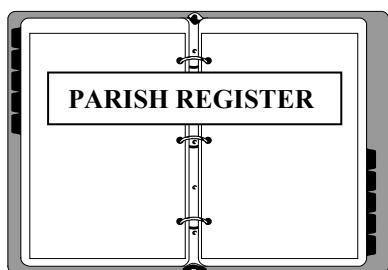

SEPTEMBER 8TH. BIRTHDAY OF THE BVM.

The Feast of the Immaculate Conception (December 8th) falls in Advent and is part of the Church's preparation for Christmas. There could not be a more appropriate place to celebrate her immaculate conception. It affirms the Church's belief that Mary, from the very moment of her conception, was preserved free from all stain of original sin. It was fitting that the mother of the Incarnate Word should thus be prepared for her role in the work of redemption. However, the timing of the feast in December was more by accident than by design, since that date was determined by the more ancient feast of the Nativity of the Virgin Mary which was celebrated today (Sept 8th) from ancient times.. When Pope Pius 1X defined the dogma of the Immaculate Conception in 1854, they had to count back 9 months from the date of today's feast in order to arrive at 8th December.
