From the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales: "The Sunday Eucharist is a gift. As God's holy people we are called to praise and thank God in the most sublime way possible. When the Church speaks of the Sunday obligation, it reminds us that attending Mass is a personal response to the selfless offering of Christ's love. At this time, we recognise that for some people there may be certain factors which hinder attendance at Sunday Mass. The pandemic is clearly not over. The risk of infection is still present. For some there is legitimate fear in gathering together. As your Bishops, we recognise that the prevailing circumstances suggest that not everyone is yet in a position to fulfil the absolute duty to attend Sunday Mass." For those who can, however, let us joyfully embrace our Sunday obligation each week, so as to celebrate and nourish our Catholic faith.

# ST. AMBROSE. Bishop and Doctor of the Church.

### (Born c.340: died 397AD)

Next Tuesday is the Feast of St. Ambrose. As we approach Christmas we need to reflect on some of those Saints who made the work of Jesus here on earth a shining light for us. St. Ambrose was an immense Biblical scholar, regarded even today as one of the foremost "Doctors of the Church". His literal output was regarded as Masterpieces of Latin eloquence. He was a very spiritual man who wanted to serve especially the poor and as Bishop of Milan, was a leader in serving the poor. He was regarded as the foremost of teachers and advised many people, including those in power, at a very difficult time in the Church's history, as it emerged out of the ruins of the Roman Empire. So we need to give thanks for his guidance, his theological forethought, and his support of the poor, at a time of great difficulty. Ambrose brought about changes with his vision and insight that could have changed so many things even for us today. [Deacon Elfed]

# THE SYNOD 2021 - 2023.

Pope Francis is calling the Bishops of the world to come together in 2023 for a special Synod which will examine the responses received from around the world - from groups and parishioners, and even those who have become disconnected with the Church for whatever reason. Pope Francis has called a Synod in 2023 which will involve all of us.

We are being called to join in and get involved in this Synodal way of being a Parish and being the Church. This is not a parliamentary system in which there are winners and losers. Instead, this is about graceful listening and graceful speaking, in which each person's contribution is valued. The conversations we have together will inform the future direction of our parish, our diocese, and our Church.

Over the next few months we will be invited to get involved in conversations springing up around the parish.

We are grateful to Mr. Bill Nolan and Dr. Martin Price for taking on this mission and task as our parish representatives for the Synod of the Universal Church. They will be organising and facilitating our response to the call of the Synod. Together we are to explore our present situation as a parish and a diocese. Then, praving and listening together to the Holy Spirit speaking through each and all of us, we will seek to discern ever more faithfully our call, to "Communion, Participation, and Mission"
