

#### Archdiocesan Lenten Alms Collection - this Weekend!

This weekend 5/6th April (5th Sunday in Lent) there will be a 2nd collection for Lenten Alms in response to Archbishop Stack's Lenten appeal. In his Pastoral Letter, read out at the beginning of Lent, the Archbishop wrote: "The work which goes on in our parishes to care for those who are in material and spiritual poverty, depends on every member of the Church. We are all parts of the One Body of Christ. That is one reason why I ask once again, that Lenten Alms are collected in parishes and sent to the Diocese so that we may help those who are in need". Details of the recipients of this collection will be announced later.
