THE NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC CONGRESS

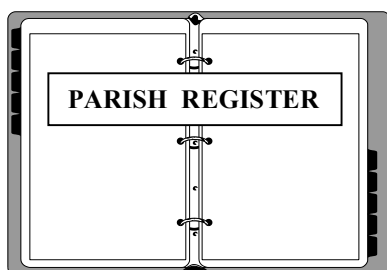
