FIRST HOLY COMMUNIONS CELEBRATED.

A special Mass took place in St. Joseph's earlier today (Saturday morning 5th June), when 14 of our children made their First Holy Communion. The celebration had to be postponed last year because of the pandemic and subsequent Lockdown. With the easing of some restrictions this year, Mgr. Joe decided to go ahead with the special Mass, even though there were limits on the number of family members who could attend and other covid precautions that affected the liturgy. Despite the restrictions, the Mass was a prayerful and joyful occasion and the children were a credit to their parents and indeed to the parish. It was also most appropriate that the event coincided with the Solemnity of The Body and Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ (Corpus Christi). We express our gratitude to the team of catechists who brought the children to the day of their First Holy Communion in the most difficult circumstances.

CONFIRMATION FINAL PREPARATION.

The final session for the Confirmandi takes place on **Monday 14th June** in St. Joseph's church at **7pm**. The actual celebration of Confirmation is on Friday 18th June at 7pm. Covid regulations will restrict attendance on the night, but **the Confirmation will be live-streamed so that all can watch**. The usual Friday night exposition and public Mass on 18th June will be cancelled.

ST. MARY'S, DINAS POWYS. UPDATE.

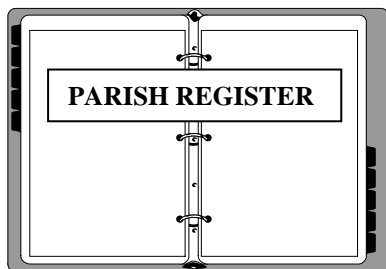
