COP 27 - CLIMATE CHANGE.

The next World COP 27 (conference of partners) about climate change is going to take place in Egypt from 6th to 18th of November. The UK, held the presidency of COP 26 in Glasgow last year and, is going to pass it on to Egypt this year. On Saturday 12th November a global day of action is organised to demand binding commitments from governments to phase out fossil fuel exploration and demand climate justice for the poorest people in the world who are already suffering from the effects of climate emergency. The Climate Justice Coalition (of which Cafod is a member) is organising a rally in Cardiff on Saturday 12th November, at 11:00 am at the Cardiff Crown Courts / National Museum, followed by a march to the Sennedd followed by a march to Central Square (by the station).
