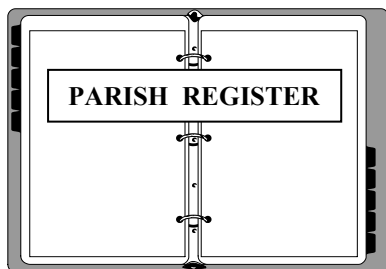
**SVP MEETING** – The next meeting of the SVP will be on **Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> April** in St. Mary's Hall.
