SYNOD UPDATE FROM ARCHBISHOP MARK

"I have just submitted the latest Report, for the two Dioceses, on the Synod, in preparation for the Second Session of the Synodal Assembly in Rome in October. You will see the focus for this period was 'How can we be a synodal Church in mission?' Our submission will feed into that made by the Bishops of England and Wales to the Synod Office in May. As I have mentioned before, the primary way in which we are taking forward the Synodal Process in these two Dioceses is through the Listening Process we are currently undertaking, which is focussed on precisely this question. This report is therefore based on the feedback that has been given through the Listening Meetings so far, as well as feedback I have received directly on the *Synthesis Report* from individuals and groups who have met in parishes, following the First Session last October."
