HOME4U ANNUAL SLEEPOUT

Roswitha Davies and Mary Ward will once again be "sleeping out" in Cardiff overnight on **Saturday 13th October** to raise funds for Home4U. The charity provides **short term accommodation** and **support to destitute asylum seekers** who have fled their homelands due to persecution. Their claims for asylum have been refused and they are **without any means of financial support or accommodation**. Home4U provides safety and security while they seek to provide new evidence for a fresh claim. **Roswitha and Mary will be collecting sponsorship from parishioners after all Masses on 27th / 28th October.**

Special envelopes are available at the back of both churches for your lists.

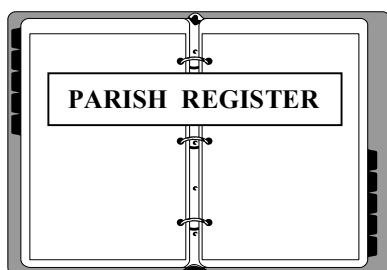
ANNUAL MASS COUNT – THIRD COUNT (OF FOUR) TODAY
