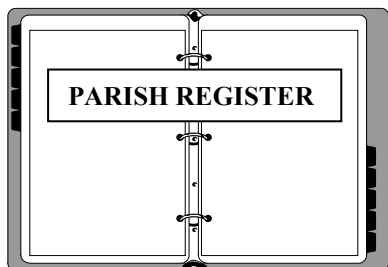

### COMING BACK TO SUNDAY MASS.

The Bishops of England and Wales are conscious that the lifting of the Sunday Obligation, which has been allowed during the pandemic, cannot go on indefinitely. Since the restriction of social distancing was lifted in August, our churches have been open to increased numbers in the congregation and there has been an average attendance of about 70-80 parishioners at each weekend Mass – well below pre-Covid levels. The streaming of Masses online will no doubt account for some of the deficit, but others have been too nervous to come back given the unpredictability in recent infection rates in Wales. However, the Bishops are hoping that by the First Sunday of Advent 2021, it will be possible for all the faithful **to attend Mass on a Sunday**, as part of the Eucharistic community once more. Let us reflect on the Bishops' words and pray about them as we are asked to take this important step.
