## Building Projects (St. Joseph's) – ongoing.

We have had to wait some months for the weather to improve before the work on the exterior wall of the Lady Chapel could continue. Canon Joe is now confident that the builder and his men will be on site in the next few days (weather permitting of course!!!). The first phase is for the stonework on the outer wall to be re-pointed and then for the outer walls to be re-rendered – all with lime mortar. When that is done the scaffolding can be removed. The re-plastering of the interior wall of the Lady Chapel with lime plaster may be delayed until next year.

**Presbytery.** The outer window frames and the fascias are in urgent need of re-painting and this will be done as soon as there is the prospect of a period of dry weather. Hopefully this will be sooner rather than later.
