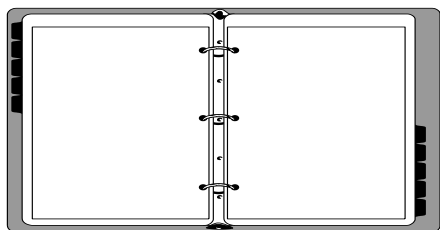

### Goodbye to the people of Musha – CAFOD.

For nearly 3 years we have been linked to the people of Musha in Rwanda through our prayer and fundraising. CAFOD's partner Avega has been working with the women in Musha, most of whom lost husbands in the genocide 20 years ago. Our parish has made a contribution to this work, collecting £4,805 via our pyramid boxes and the CAFOD box in St. Mary's. The conditions in Musha have improved greatly through CAFOD's support and so it is time for CAFOD to move on to peacekeeping work in the north of Rwanda. From now on our contributions will again go into the CAFOD general fund. Thank you for your continuing generosity.
