#### MISSIO – RED BOXES

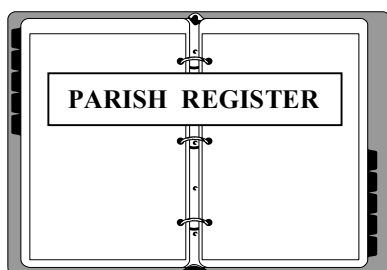
