CONFESSIONS ON REQUEST IN ST. JOSEPH'S.

CYCLE OF PRAYER FOR PARISHES.

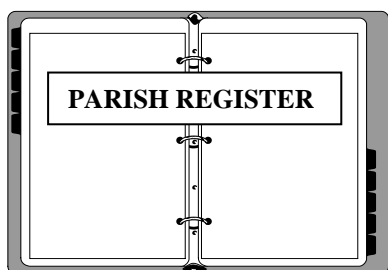

RESPONDING TO THE LIFTING OF SOME COVID RESTRICTIONS IN WALES.

This week the First Minister made the announcement we were expecting, that from this weekend, some of the Covid restrictions that have been imposed on us until now, will be lifted with effect from **Saturday 7th August**. This brings Wales largely in line with England, where similar restrictions were lifted on July 19th.

At the time of writing, it is not clear what the implications of these moves will be on us, and how they will impact on the liturgical life of the parish. As far as we are concerned things will, in the main, have to stay as they are in the immediate aftermath of **7th August**, to allow for a period of re-evaluation to take place. At each stage risk assessments will have to be in place to make sure that the safety of all comes first.

Next Tuesday 10th August, Mgr. Joe will meet with a small team of advisors, who have been with him throughout the duration of the pandemic, and they will discuss the proposals put forward by the Welsh Government and then respond accordingly. They will also bear in mind the guidelines issued by the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales. Despite the new "freedoms" people are enjoying at the moment, the virus is still "out there" and new variants could emerge at any time in the longer term. Our double jabs will afford us some protection of course, but nevertheless we must proceed with caution. You will be kept informed via the

STREAMING AND BUFFERING. UPDATE.

At the beginning of July some of those watching the Mass on stream were experiencing significant interruptions in the transmission because either the image on the screen "froze"; or the sound was not in sync, or both. Mgr. Joe spoke to the firm that installed the camera and broadband, and they in turn contacted the Streaming Service they use, explaining our problems and looking for their assurance that they are looking into them. It transpired that it was not just ourselves that were affected but rather it was far more widespread.

The following reply has been received from the Streaming Service Provider (IPCam):
"Our development team has found the issue that caused the buffering on your streams. The issue was on our server side and the buffering happened because our server was not able to balance the loads. We are having more and more users/viewers and some of our new Linux servers are not able to correctly handle large numbers of viewers. For now, we have assigned all your cameras to our windows-based servers, which are working correctly. In the meantime our development team will fix our Linux servers, so that in future the transcoding will work properly and no buffering will occur".
