THE OCTOBER COUNT- EXTENDED.

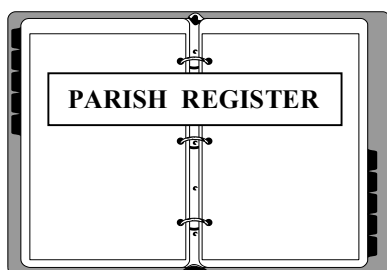
