Brian is currently Parish Priest in St. Cadoc's, Llanrumney. Archbishop Mark thanked him for his generosity in agreeing to take on this Office. He also thanked Mgr. Joe Boardman, for his exceptionally dedicated service in this role these past years. Mgr. Joe will remain as Parish Priest of Penarth and Dinas Powys, as well as retaining the other offices he holds. He will be overseeing a handover to Fr. Brian in the period between now and Advent.

#### SYNOD OF BISHOPS 2023 OCT 4<sup>th</sup> – 29<sup>th</sup> then OCT 2024

The first part of the Synod has begun in Rome and will continue until the end of October. A three-year 'synodal' process is taking place in the Catholic Church that culminates in two Synodal gatherings in Rome in October 2023 and a year later in 2024. The overall theme is "For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, Mission".
