RACIAL JUSTICE SUNDAY – NEXT WEEK

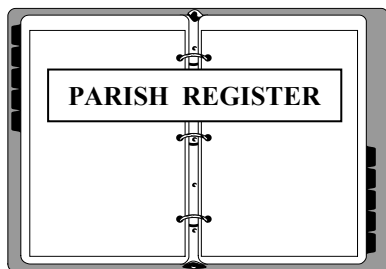

INVITATION FROM THE DEAN OF HEREFORD CATHEDRAL – FRIDAY 17th APRIL

In 2020, at **Hereford Cathedral**, we are celebrating the **700th anniversary** of the **Canonisation of Thomas Cantilupe** on **17th April 1320** by **Pope John XXII** and a year-long programme of events is already underway.

We have close links with Belmont Abbey and with the church of **St. Francis Xavier** and after discussions with the Abbot and other Catholic friends, we have the pleasure in hosting the **celebration of Mass** on the **actual anniversary of the Canonisation – Friday 17th April 2020 at 11.00am**.

Mass will be celebrated by the **Archbishop of Cardiff, the Most Revd George Stack** and during Mass, there will be a procession to the **refurbished shrine** of **St. Thomas**, in the north transept. Here will be displayed, for veneration, **relics of St. Thomas**, for which the Cathedral is caring during this festival year (relics owned by Downside Abbey and Stonyhurst College).

The Abbot and the Dean of Hereford feel that this is a **wonderful opportunity** to invite **priests** and **congregations** from the **Archdiocese of Cardiff** and also from neighbouring parishes in Birmingham Archdiocese. They would be delighted to welcome you here for this historic occasion.

Would all users of St. Joseph's Hall please note that some of the wooden structure of the building is in the process of being repaired and renewed externally, and then it will be refurbished internally afterwards. Work on the rear of the property was carried out and completed last week and work on the front of the hall begins this coming week. The interior refurbishment will take place during half term when **THE HALL WILL BE CLOSED FOR ONE WEEK. (ie. Mon 17th to Fri 21st Feb)**.

This work has necessitated the fitting of two new doors front and back. **Both doors will have new locks requiring new keys.** Some extra keys will be cut during half term but for this coming week, until the new front door is fitted, the old front door key can be used.
