Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord (Year A) April 9th 2017

1st Reading: Isaiah 50:4-7

The suffering servant of Isaiah assures us of our victory over suffering.

Ps 21:8-9. 17-20. 23-24. R v.2

My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?

2nd Reading: Philippians 2:6-11

Christ's suffering is deeper than we imagine but his exaltation is also higher than we can imagine.

Acclamation: Phil 2:8-9

*Praise to you, O Christ, king of eternal glory:
Christ was humbler yet,
even to accepting death, death on a cross.
But God raised him high
and gave him the name which is above all names.

Gospel: Matthew 26:14 – 27:66

Matthew describes the death of Christ in terms of destruction, yet this destruction brings the dead back to life and reveals the unshakeable reality of heaven.

Wednesday evening - Mass of the Day in St. Mary's at 7pm.

THE TRIDUUM

This begins on **Maundy Thursday** evening with the **Mass of the Lord's Supper** at 7.30pm in **St. Joseph's**. This is followed by **Eucharistic Adoration** at the Altar of Repose (Lady Chapel) until 10.30pm. At 10.15pm the **Sorrowful Mysteries** of the **Holy Rosary** will be recited, taking us from the Garden of Gethsemane to Calvary.

GOOD FRIDAY at 3pm - We resume our journey in the footsteps of **Our Blessed Lord** with the **Solemn Good Friday Liturgy** in **St. Joseph's**.

HOLY SATURDAY at 8.30pm – We celebrate with joy together the **Easter Vigil Mass** in **St. Joseph's**. (During the Vigil Mass our two candidates Stephen and Eve will be received into Full Communion with the Church).

STATIONS OF THE CROSS AND BENEDICTION

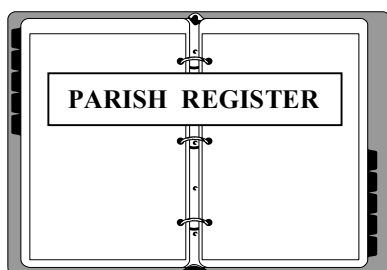
HOLY PLACES COLLECTION – Good Friday
