**THE LORD IS RISEN. ALLELLUIA.** Mgr Joe and Deacon Elfed wish all our parishioners a very happy and joyful Easter. May the light of the Risen Christ penetrate our worries and uncertainties in these extraordinary times.

**EASTER WATER**. After the blessing of the Easter Water during the Easter Vigil Mass in St, Joseph's, and during the Easter morning Mass in St. Mary's, some of the holy water will be once again be put into the water stoops at the entrances to both churches so that parishioners can bless themselves with it as they enter and leave.

**EASTER OCTAVE – WEEKDAY MASSES**. During the Octave of Easter, morning Mass in St. Joseph's will be celebrated **at the later time of 10am**, except for Friday when there will be an evening Mass after exposition of the Blessed Sacrament. 

**HOLY OILS – WHAT ARE THEY?** The Chrism Mass which was celebrated last Tuesday in the Cathedral in Cardiff, is the celebration of the year that gathers together the entire Archdiocese, bishop, priests, deacons, religious, and laity. At this Mass, the Oil of the Sick and the Oil of Catechumens were blessed, and the Oil of Chrism was consecrated by the Archbishop. All three Oils form an important part of the sacramental life of our two parish communities during the year.

The Oil of the sick will be used throughout the coming year in the anointing of the sick, in our homes, care homes, and hospitals. The Oil of Catechumens will be used in the prebaptismal anointing of both adults and children. The Oil of Chrism, which may only be consecrated by a bishop, is used at Baptism, Confirmation, and the Anointing of priests and bishops. As the bishop is not able to be present at all Baptisms through out the diocese, this special consecration and distribution links him with these celebrations. The Oil of Chrism is also used to anoint new alters and churches.

The oil used is pure olive oil, but balsam and other sweetsmelling oils are added to the Chrism because of its particular usage. After the Mass of Chrism, Mgr Joe brought the new oils back to the parish and they were formally carried to the altar in the offertory procession during the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Maundy Thursday evening in St. Joseph's.

**EASTER OFFERINGS.** The Easter Offering envelopes and the "loose plate" will constitute the traditional Easter Offerings to the priest, while the gift-aid envelopes and non gift-aid will go to the parish.
