Mission Appeal-This weekend.

We warmly welcome Fr Emmanuel to celebrate Masses with us this weekend. He is a missionary priest from the Holy Ghost Fathers (now called the Spiritans). The first Spiritan mission in 1925 went to Sierra Leone from there, they went to Nigeria, Mauritius, east Africa, and the Caribbean.

From the beginning the missionaries encouraged local vocations. In Nigeria for example today there are close to a million and a half Catholics now split into several dioceses each with their own Nigerian Bishop and clergy. As they begin their third century of service, British Spiritans are to be found all over the world working alongside Spiritans from over 50 nations, and they welcome others to be trained here in the UK. In 2015 the Spiritans elected a new Provincial Director who comes from Nigeria.

The second collection this weekend will be given to support them in their work. Their work is important and valuable in spreading the good news to those who are yet to hear.

National Eucharistic Congress- this weekend

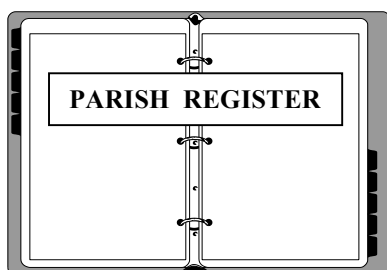
