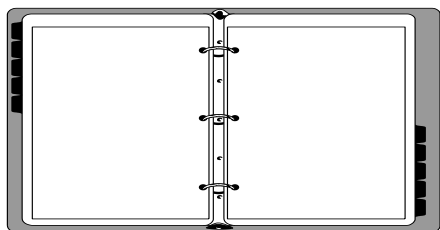

### The Light is ON for US

"*The Light is ON for You*", invites practising and lapsed Catholics to go to Confession this Advent. In common with other dioceses across England and Wales, we are reaching out to those who may have wandered from the life of the Church and those Mass-going Catholics who have been away from Confession for some years. Each Wednesday of Advent participating Catholic Parish Churches in the Archdiocese of Cardiff will be open from **7pm to 8pm on 3<sup>rd</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> December** for Catholics to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation. This means that "*The Light is ON for You*" at these times in St. Joseph's, Penarth.

Mgr John Maguire, parish priest of St. Mary's, Canton will be hearing confessions in Penarth, while Canon Joe will go to Canton.

### Fr. Donal Gillespie R.I.P.

Fr. Donal was a retired priest who for many years had been parish priest in St. Joseph of Arimathea, Pyle, nr. Bridgend. He died in the Princess of Wales Hospital, Bridgend on Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> November after a fall outside the church in Pyle the previous evening. He was 85 years old and had been a diocesan priest for 55 years. Funeral arrangements are as follows: His body will be received into St. Joseph of Arimathea, Pyle, on Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> Nov. at 7pm. Following Mass, his body will lie overnight in St. Joseph's. Due to the size of the church, this will primarily be a Liturgy for the parish community.

On Friday 14<sup>th</sup> Nov. at 12 noon, the funeral Mass will be celebrated at Our Lady, Star of the Sea, Porthcawl. Following Mass his body will be taken to Omagh for burial.
