The Archdiocesan Commission for Christian Unity has published recently a small book entitled ‘**Towards Christian Unity**’. This is to mark the fiftieth celebration of the Decree *Unitatis Redintegratio* (The Restoration of Unity) which was promulgated on the 21st of November 1964 by the Second Vatican Council. Archbishop George Stack has written a foreword to the book reminding us of the challenge and commitment to all Christians to follow the prayer of Jesus – ‘**That they may all be one**’. The book is now available to download from the diocesan website. It can be copied, and it is hoped that it can be used for personal prayer and reflection and help groups in discussions together – especially perhaps for local ‘Churches Together’ and ‘Cytûn’ groups.
