HOLY WEEK AND THE SACRED TRIDUUM.

Holy Week begins today with the celebration of the triumphal entry of Our Lord into Jerusalem and the blessing of palms.. The Sacred Triduum begins on **Holy Thursday** in St. Joseph's with the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7.30pm, followed by the Altar of Repose until 10.30pm. On **Good Friday** the Solemn Liturgy is at 3pm in St. Joseph's.

On **Holy Saturday** there are confessions from 10am-11am. At 8.30pm on Holy Saturday night, there is the **Easter Vigil** in St. Joseph's with the accompanying liturgies.

HOLY WEEK SERVICES.

This year we are able to celebrate Holy Week without many of the Covid restrictions that hindered us last year. This year each Service is open to a full congregation and will be celebrated in their fullness as far as is safe and possible to do so.

The Chrism Mass takes place in St. David's Cathedral on Tuesday 12th April at 11.30am.
