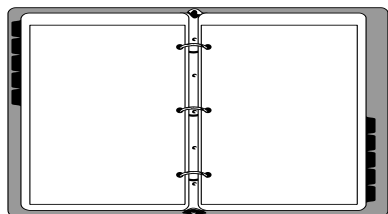

The official opening will take the form of prayer, drama, music and displays in a short celebration to be attended by representatives of the feeder primary schools and any members of the community who would like to come. The commemoration will take place on **Friday 15th May** at the school from 11.30am to 12.30pm.
