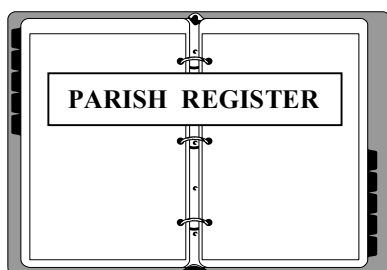
DAY FOR LIFE – 17th June (NEXT WEEK)

The **Day for Life** this year will provide us with an **opportunity to pray for and remember** all those lives lost before birth and to offer practical, spiritual and emotional support to **women and men** who have been **affected by issues surrounding abortion** or who are worried and concerned about unwanted pregnancy. For those who have had an abortion, the words of **Pope Francis** will be a comfort and a challenge: "...there is no sin that God's mercy cannot reach and wipe away when it finds a repentant heart seeking to be reconciled to the Father". There will be a **second collection** on **17th June** to support the work of **Day for Life**. Proceeds from this collection are allocated to the **Anscombe Bioethics Centre** and other Church supported life activities.

DO YOU USE YOUR CAR ON 'PARISH BUSINESS'? – The Diocesan Health and Safety Executive

require **all parishioners who use their car on 'parish business'**, i.e. journeys connected with the Church / Parish, to **consider the following statements and act upon them** accordingly. This applies to **parishioners exercising all kinds of ministries** e.g. visiting the sick, hospital visits, SVP, purchasing items such as flowers for the church and similar undertakings. Please ensure that:

- You have a valid driving licence;
- You have an up to date MOT certificate;
- **You are insured to drive for reasons related to parish 'business' in addition to 'social, domestic and pleasure' (if you are in doubt check with your insurers);**
- Your road tax is up to date;
- Your vehicle is in a roadworthy condition;
- You do not have any medical condition which could result in the DVLA disqualifying you from driving.

DO YOU KNOW SOMEONE WHO IS IN HOSPITAL? PLEASE READ THIS

Do you know someone who is in hospital? – either in UHW, Llandough Hosp, or Marie Curie, Holme Tower? IT IS VITAL THAT YOU TELL THE PARISH CLERGY IMMEDIATELY (see phone numbers in left hand column) OR THE PARISH HOSPITAL CHAPLAINCY CO-ORDINATOR (on 029 20515309) OR UHW CHAPLAINCY ON 029 2074 3230. Otherwise the chaplaincy team will not know that the person is there. Due to the Data Protection Act, the team no longer has access to the list of Admissions. If no one from the Church has been to see the person in hospital, it is because they do not know the person is there.
