#### The Middle East in Turmoil.

CAFOD is working with Caritas Jerusalem, Catholic Relief Services, and Islamic Relief Palestine, on the ground in Gaza, to get humanitarian aid to the thousands of displaced persons there. This can only happen if the fragile truce holds. Then there is the situation facing Christians in Iraq. Christians are being driven out of Iraq at the moment, often without any of their possessions, fleeing over difficult mountains to safety – to say nothing of the continuing civil war in Syria. We are asked to pray that God will bring a just and lasting peace to the region. For the moment people can donate to the Gaza Appeal through the Disaster Emergency Committee Appeal (of which Cafod is a member) at Banks and other financial institutions as announced in the Press.
