J&P GROUP HANDOUT TODAY.

Members of the Justice and Peace Group will be distributing their Handout which updates the Parish on the projects with which they have been involved in recent months. This will be available on the weekends of Sept 10th (today) and 17th. You will read about CAFOD "Fix the Food System Campaign", which is focusing particularly on seeds. Small farmers who produce the majority of the world's food, need to be able to choose which seeds to plant and should also be able to share these seeds among the farming community. This right is being taken away from them by big institutions and international Corporations. Thousands of people in many parishes across Britain have already told the UK Government to urge the World Bank to protect the rights of farmers. You too will have a chance to sign the letter of support for Salina, a small-scale farmer from Bangladesh, who has written to the World Bank herself on this important matter. The signing will take place after Masses today and next week.
