### A MESSAGE FOR PARENTS: SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION 2022.

We have every intention of running the Sacramental Preparation Programmes for 2022, starting in the New Year. This involves First Holy Communion (St. Joseph's), First Holy Communion (St. Mary's), and Confirmation (St. Joseph's & St. Mary's together).

What we need **NOW** are the names of the children who want to make their First Holy Communion, or who want to be Confirmed next year.

In the case of **First Holy Communion** it is children currently in Year 4 (last year's Year 3 who missed out because of Covid) and this year's Year 3.

In the case of **Confirmation** it is pupils in year 9 (last year's Year 8) and those currently in Year 8.
